### PARKING AUTHORITY OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN 2016 Authority Budget

 The 2016 Authority Budget anticipates an increase in revenue due to renewal of four residential parking permit zones, an increase in rental space rates, the possibility of adding additional rental spaces and the addition of three pay and display machines that will operate when the Parking Authority is closed.

### **Explanation of Variances:**

### Page F-2, 2016 Revenue Schedule

### Parking Fees:

The Authority permit revenues are expected to increase approximately 20% due to four residential zones renewing all residential parking permits and a rate increase for permits in the rented municipal parking lots.

### Fines/Penalties:

The Authority may not reach the budgeted revenue for fines in 2015 due to the inability to enforce during the harsh winter months. With lack of enforcement due to inclement weather a possibility in 2016, the Authority has adjusted the anticipated revenues for this category.

### Page F-4, 2016 Appropriations Schedule

### Operation Appropriations, Administration – Other:

The Authority anticipates exploring adding additional rental spaces and parking lot projects in the upcoming year. This will require additional professional services such as an appraiser and surveyor resulting in the budgeted increase.

### Non-Operating Appropriations:

The Authority decreased the amount of the Municipal Appropriation by 35%. The decrease came as a result of the Authority having to pay down a \$200,000.00 obligation to the Township after entering into a 15-year Amortization Schedule that begins in 2016. The funds were loaned by the Township to cover the Authority's anticipated capital projects that include placing security cameras in Parking Authority parking lots and garage improvements.

The Authority continues to be committed to serving the community at a fair and reasonable charge. Increases may be attributed to an increase in parking lot rental spaces that become available, and the assumption of street sweeping violations.

- 3. As the economy changes, so must the Authority. The need for the Authority to provide parking and services to the Township continues to grow.
- The necessity to expand and improve services and to pay down the capital obligation owed to the Township will require some use of unrestricted net assets to fund capital projects.
- 5. Funds being transferred to the Municipality as a budget subsidy are expensed from the Authority's operating account.

### RESOLUTION NO.: 2015-019

WHEREAS, pursuant to NJSA 40:11A-6, one of the purposes of a parking authority is the construction of off-street parking projects to promote the free movement of traffic, relief of congestion on the streets and the improvement of conditions affecting the public safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Township of North Bergen ("Township") will be issuing a bond for various Township capital projects; and

WHEREAS, the North Bergen Parking Authority ("Authority") will also be undertaking various capital projects, including the installation of cameras in various parking lots and garage and sidewalk renovations, for which it requires capital funding in the amount of \$200,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Township and Authority will realize administrative cost savings for the North Bergen citizens if the funds needed for these capital projects are combined into one debt issue, rather than the Township and Authority each issuing separate debt instruments; and

WHEREAS, the Township and the Authority wish to enter an interlocal services agreement pursuant to the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-4, et seq., to provide for the Township issuing the debt to include an additional \$200,000.00, which will be allocated to the Parking Authority for its capital project(s), and providing for a repayment schedule pursuant to which the Authority will repay the Township for the debt service for the funds allocated to the Authority, as well as its share of administrative costs; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the proposed Interlocal Services Agreement between the Township and Authority ("Agreement") is on file in the Parking Authority Offices and incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Commissioners of the North Bergen Parking Authority, that the Agreement is hereby authorized and approved, with such changes as the Township Attorney and General Counsel deem necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Chairman, Executive Director, General Counsel, Board Secretary and any other necessary official, officer or employee of the Parking Authority be and they are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents and to take any and all actions necessary to complete and realize the intent and purpose of this Resolution, including the execution of the final "Agreement."
